

## Calendar

The school year is divided into four marking periods of approximately nine weeks in length. The school day is divided into ten class periods of 40 minutes each. We operate on a two-day cycle with all major subjects (English, Social Studies, Math, Science, World Language and Religion) meeting every day. Students take mid-term and final exams at the end of each semester.

### AVERAGE TEST SCORES

### IB DATA (scores range from 1-7)

In the 2023-24 school year, 53 students in grades 11-12 took 110 IB exams in 9 subject areas

- 91% of the scores were 3 or above
- 56% of the scores were 4 or above
- 23% of the scores were 5 or above
- 3% of the scores were 6 or above

### AP DATA (scores range from 1-5)


In the 2023-24 school year, 32 students in grades 10-12 took a total of 32 AP exams in 2 subject areas

- 16% of the scores were 3 or higher
- 6% of the scores were 4 or higher
- 3% of the scores were 5 or higher

### NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

In the second semester of their junior year, students who have a five semester cumulative average of 90% or higher are academically qualified to apply for induction into Bishop Ludden's National Honor Society, Lumen Christi Chapter. Students must also demonstrate leadership, character, and service to the school and community.

**\*Honors:** A student earns a computed average of at least 90 on the Regents examination applicable to either a Regents diploma or a Regents diploma with advanced designation.

**\*Mastery in Math/Science:** A student meets all the requirements for a Regents diploma with advanced designation AND earns a score of 85 or better on 3 math/science Regents exams
