
CNY Winter Invitational II Quiz Bowl Results



Bishop Ludden's A Team finished 5-4 to take fifth place at the 2025 Central New York CNY Winter Invitational II Quiz Bowl Tournament at Bishop Ludden on March 1st. The B team scored three wins, while the C Team had a win against Geneva B. All-Star Momin Naveed was Bishop Ludden's top scorer with 355 points, while Mya Barnaba was also an All-Star with 325 points.

Every single player on the three teams scored, with seventh graders Aidan Ewanyk and Alibariki Kabulete scoring 55 and 5 points respectively against high school players on NAQT Packet 235. Ithaca won the tournament with a perfect record, followed by Mayfield and Geneva A. Payton Campbell scored 260, while senior Aidan Grealish-Liquori added 210, with Alex Ewanyk rounding out the A team scoring with 135. Anthony Taylor scored 100, with Asimwe Kabulete at 90, with Noor Naveed at 35. Nina Barraco and Sophia Azria tied with 30 apiece.

Holy Family's sixth grade squad scored a win against high school teams! Great job by Alexander Straight, Alex Murry, James Ryan, and Brady Davis. The team is mentored by Bishop Ludden Coach Maxine Babcock and varsity star Mya Barnaba. Alexander scored 65, James added 40, and Alex scored 5.
