

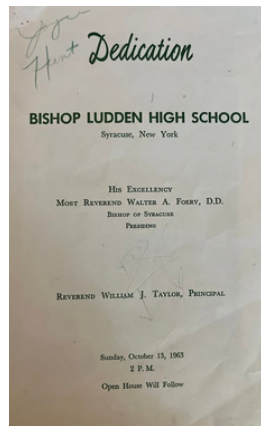

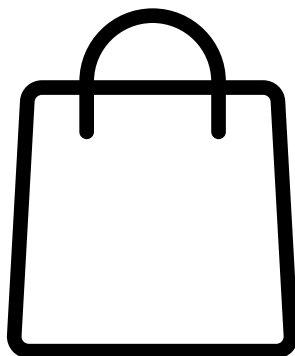

Congratulations to Molly Smith, class of 2025, for her amazing accomplishments in academics and music!

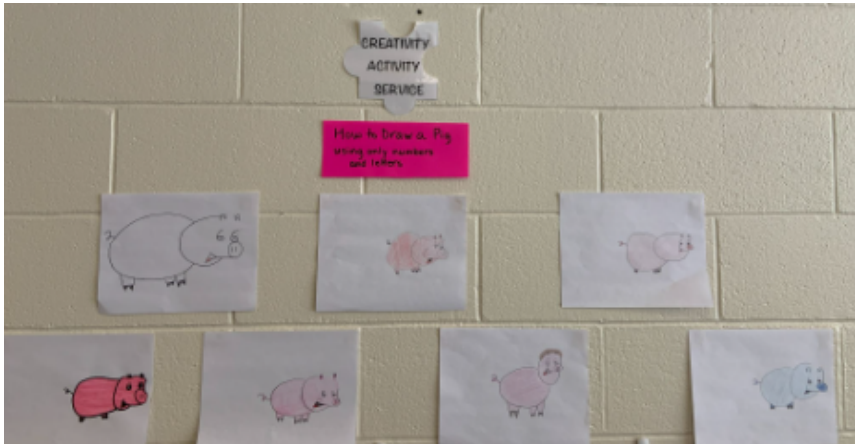
Molly was recognized as a commended student in the National Merit Scholarship Competition for her excellent score on her PSAT and demonstration of academic rigor.

Important Note

IB has changed the policy regarding the 150 hours. According to IB, the policy states that the school sets the goal for hours in each category and the emphasis is to be on quality rather than quantity. However, IB does require that students are engaged in each strand (creativity, activity, and service) **weekly** for 18 months. The breakdown of hours seems to help the students see it as a weekly task. We address the quality of their CAS experiences by discussing and reflecting in our journals on the experience, including the CAS stages and learning outcomes.

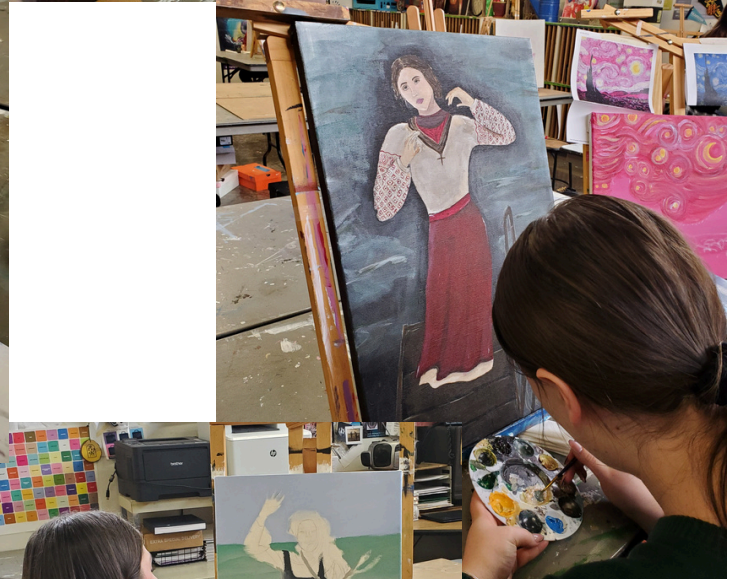

Bishop Ludden Wins Small School Award at Midstate Science Olympiad C Regionals

Bishop Ludden's varsity squad had the best finish in school history, missing qualifying for Science Olympiad C States by one place in team overall score at LeMoyne College on January 25. The team brought home 16 medals, awarded based on individual/partner/trio events, and their combined efforts contributed towards winning the Small School Award. Our students competed in 23 events including testing, problem-solving, or building events.



Head Coach Maxine Babcock, the Site Coordinator for Midstate Science Olympiad B Regionals, along with Coaches Katherine Babcock, Grace Babcock, Alexa Kulak, and volunteers Nadia and Noor Naveed, ensured the day ran smoothly for everyone.



Aidan Grealish-Liquori finished his illustrious six year Science Olympiad career with bronze medals in Experimental Design with Mya Barnaba and Momin Naveed. He followed that with bronze in Tower with junior Gabriella Berry, and finished with a surprise medal in Helicopter with Momin. Momin also medaled in Codebusters with Mya and Anthony. Mya medaled in Astronomy with Theresa Quigley. Anthony medaled with Alex Ewanyk in Disease Detectives, then medaled in Robot Tour with Kira Ray. Junior Payton Campbell and sophomores Sophia Azra and Caitlyn Coryell contributed to the Small School Award with solid performances in their events.

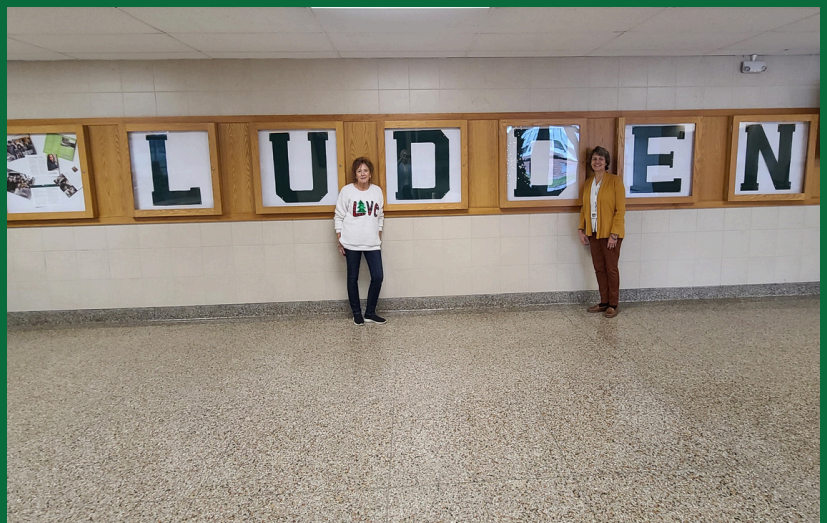
