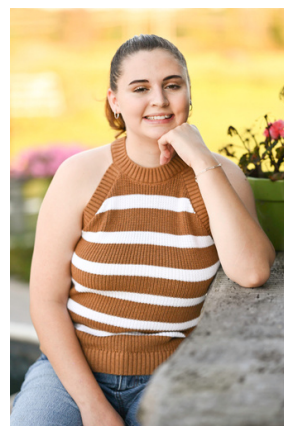

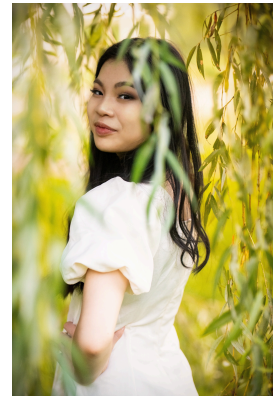

2024-2025 School Year Health Requirements

All students entering 7, 9 and 11th grade and all new students MUST have an updated physical. Any physical after 9/3/2023 is acceptable.

All students entering 7th grade MUST have 1 dose of the Meningococcal vaccine, and all students entering 12th grade MUST have 2 doses of the Meningococcal vaccine PRIOR to the first day of school.

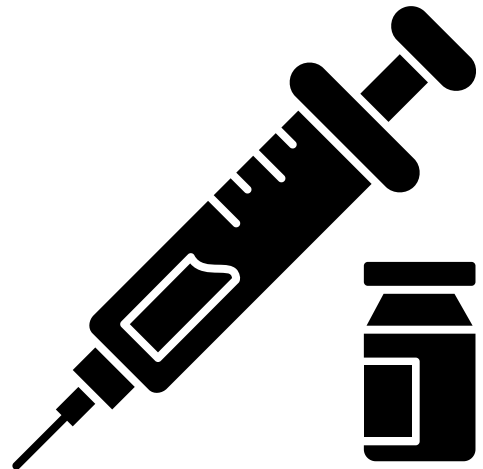

Working Papers

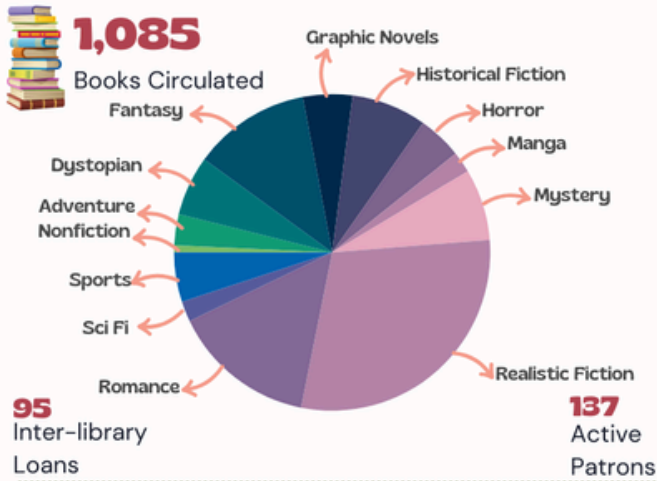
If a student will need working papers for the summer please have them get them from the Health Office prior to June 21st. A completed employment application form and a physical within the past 12 months is needed.

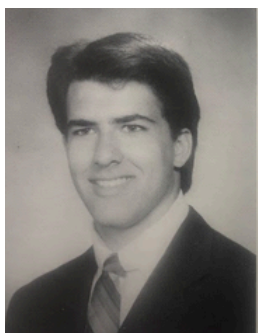
"As a deacon, you know ... you want to be humble. But there is this sense of real pride in what has been accomplished here," he said.
